

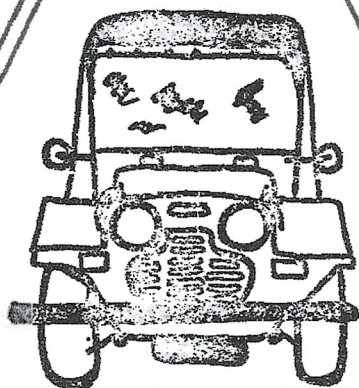

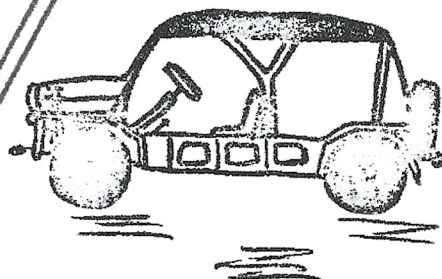

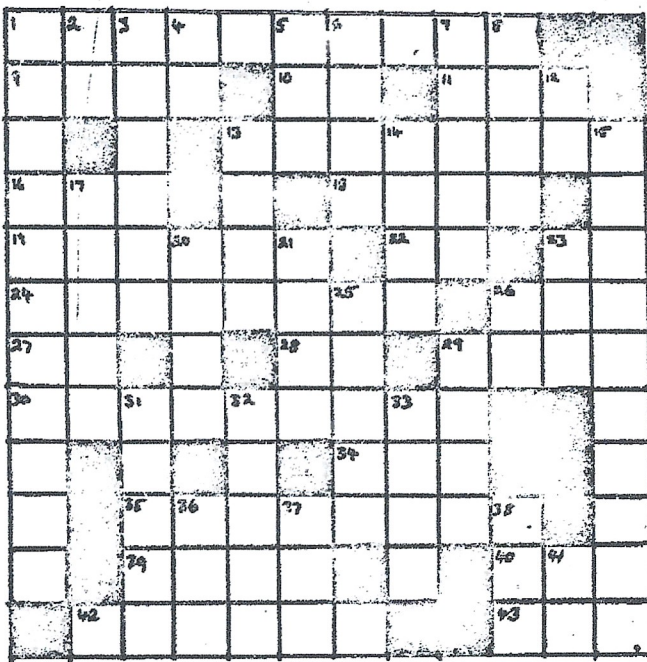
Dear Mokees,

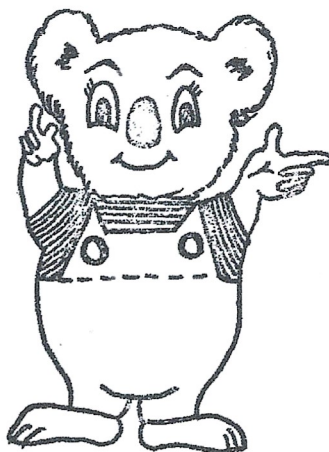

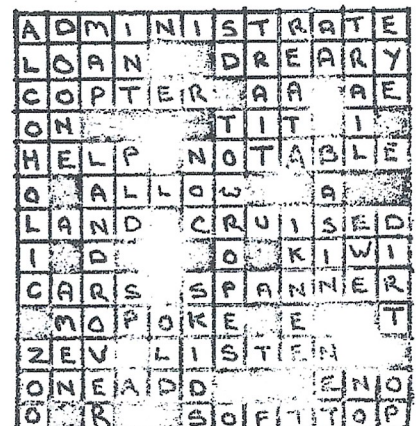
