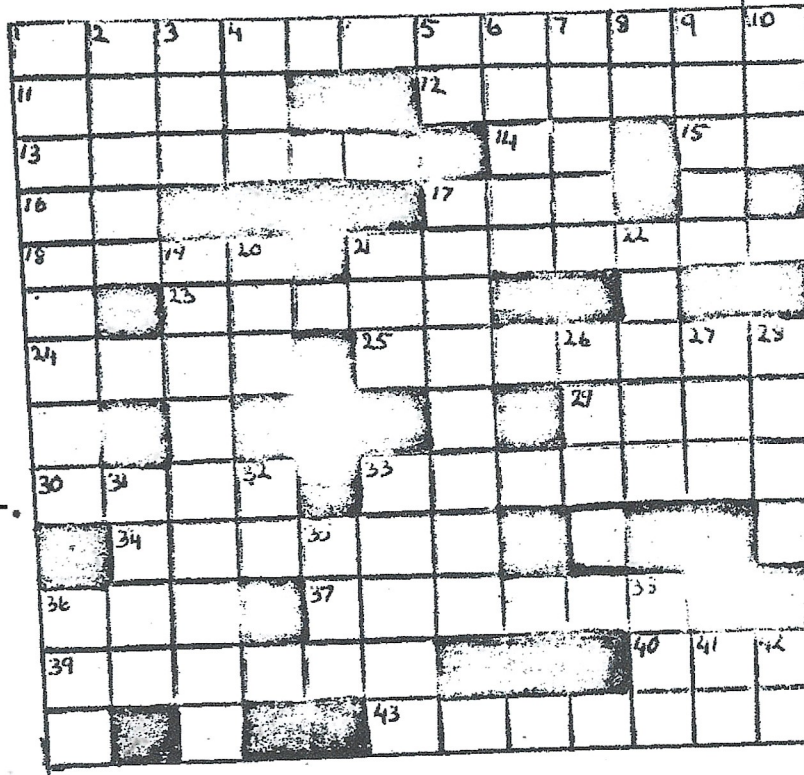
Anyway back to business, here are the dated to remember.
